**ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION**

The proposed *Staff Mobility for Training* will be strictly aligned with the strategic priorities of our partnerships. Specifically:

Academic Alignment & Thematic Staff Weeks: Although categorized as Staff Training, all activities will be directly related to the ISCED fields specified in the Inter-institutional Agreements with each partner university, ensuring high-level professional development within the relevant disciplinary sectors. Specifically, for partnerships involving ISCED 0541 (Mathematics) and ISCED 0588 (Interdisciplinary programmes and qualifications involving natural sciences, mathematics and statistics), a dedicated Thematic Staff Week has been organized from June 8<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026, to foster specialized administrative and technical cooperation (in particular Modelling and HPC, Cyber Security).

Global Coalition for Ukrainian Studies: In line with the University of L'Aquila's commitment to this international coalition, a specific Staff Week for Ukrainian academic staff will be held from June 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026. This mobility will focus on themes related to the preservation of Ukrainian academic heritage and the strengthening of research resilience under the Coalition's framework.

Double Degree Management: For institutions with active Double Degree agreements, training can focus on the complex administrative management and academic coordination required to ensure the sustainability and success of these joint programs.

This targeted approach ensures that the training is not generic but acts as a driver for institutional capacity building and the sustainability of existing strategic collaborations.

### **Procedure for the selection of staff**

Each University, included in the project, will carry out the selection of the participants according to the following **criteria**:

1. The selection must be fair, transparent and well-documented, and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process.
2. The selection criteria shall be made public and according to the following criteria:
  - a. Candidate's CV, including English or Italian level proficiency (maximum 40 pts);
  - b. Mobility agreement (maximum 40 pts): Consistency of the proposed Work Programme with the activity description, the specific ISCED fields of the agreement, and/or the strategic objectives of the Double Degree management or the Global Coalition for Ukrainian Studies;
  - c. Further certifications (maximum 20 pts).

### **Minimum score: 60/100 pts**

The HEI shall take the necessary measures to prevent any conflict of interest with regard to persons who may be invited to take part in the selection bodies or selection process.

Each University will send the International Relations Office ([credit.mobility@struttura.univaq.it](mailto:credit.mobility@struttura.univaq.it)):

- the minutes of the selection;
  - an Excel file with all the information regarding candidates and scores given according to the selection criteria listed above;
  - an official nomination letter;
- b. Documents to be sent to UNIVAQ for each selected candidate:
- candidate's CV;
  - training agreement proposal;
  - a copy of the passport;
  - Further certifications

**Partner Universities may select up to 3 staff members. However, for UzhNU and KAI, the limit is extended to 5.**

**Deadline: 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026**

**Staff mobility must end by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2026.**

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**The budget available for this call corresponds to all the remaining funds allocated for Region 2 of the project.**

Once all documents arrive from all Partner universities, an academic committee at UnivAQ will be nominated in order to evaluate the applications received. A selection will be made and a single ranking will be created (by merit).

The selection process will prioritize the two highest-ranked eligible applicants per institution.

The remaining funds available at the moment of the selection will be used to select the best candidates from the remaining candidates in the single ranking (regardless of their institution of affiliation).

The single ranking of eligible candidates remains valid until the end of the project (31<sup>st</sup> July 2026): if additional funds become available, the single ranking will be used as long as there are still eligible candidates on the list.
