**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
THE ALEKSANDËR MOISIU UNIVERSITY, DURRËS (ALBANIA)  
AND  
KHARKIV NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF RADIO ELECTRONICS (UKRAINE)**

The Aleksandër Moisiu University, Durrës, (hereafter referred to as UAMD) and the Kharkiv National University of Radio Electronics, (hereafter referred to as NURE) recognizing the benefits to their respective institutions from the establishment of this international collaboration, sign this Memorandum of Understanding with the purpose of developing an academic and educational cooperation and of promoting mutual understanding between the two universities.

**Scopes of cooperation**

UAMD and the NURE agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

- a) Exchange of faculty and/or administrative staff;
- b) Exchange of graduate and/or undergraduate students for study and/or placement semesters;
- c) Joint research activities and publications;
- d) Participation in seminars, conferences, events and academic meetings;
- e) Exchange of academic materials and other information;
- f) Special short-term academic programs.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity.

**Renewal, Termination and Amendment**

The Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by the appropriate authorities of either party giving twelve months notice to the other party in writing, unless an earlier termination date is mutually agreed upon. The Memorandum of Understanding may be amended or extended by mutual written consent of the two parties.
