

# SUSTAINABILITY REPORT «REDUCED INEQUALITIES» 2020



Today, the University has 105 students with disabilities, more than 60% of them are registered at the dispensary.

The legal basis for ensuring the rights and legitimate interests of persons with special needs, employees and students of the University, is the Constitution of Ukraine, Decree of the President of Ukraine of December 13, 2016 № 553 « On measures aimed at ensuring observance of the rights of persons with disabilities ", laws of Ukraine"On education", "On higher education", "On bases of social protection of disabled people of Ukraine"Resolution of the Cabinet of the Ministers of Ukraine of July 10, 2019 № 635 "Procedure for organizing inclusive education in higher education institutions" and others.

In 2020, the accounting and analysis of the psychophysical condition of students with special educational needs was conducted on the basis of the developed information support system for students with special educational needs.

There is a constant consultation and training of faculty and other staff of the university to work with students with special educational needs.

Systematic consultative work is carried out with parents and students of boarding schools and special educational institutions on the possibility of admission of persons with disabilities to NURE, in particular in the 8th, 12th and 55th boarding schools of Kharkiv.

Computer systems and devices necessary for the adaptation of students with special educational needs to the educational environment of the University are constantly being developed.

During 2020, the software and hardware complex developed by the employees of the department and installed in the scientific library of NURE for enlarging the image on paper media, for the integration of students with visual problems, was modernized.

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The advantages of using new educational technologies and tools are ease of implementation, originality of tests and flexible adaptation to different ages of a person or child with special educational needs, adaptation to various high-definition digital devices, ergonomics of wireless pen or stylus, use as an interactive simulator for pupils of specialized correctional educational institutions.

The main task of inclusive education in higher education institutions is to provide full and quality education to people with disabilities on equal terms, which will allow them to be realized in later life.

Advisory, volunteer and methodological assistance is provided at Kharkiv Special School named after V.G. Korolenko under the public work agreement.

Developed and prepared for publication "Guidelines for training of people with special educational needs".

The staff of NURE takes part in the elaboration of draft Laws of Ukraine and draft resolutions of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine on persons with special educational needs (submission of proposals and comments).

January 21, 2020 Kharkiv Regional Branch of the Social Protection Fund for Disabled Persons on the basis of the short-lived institution "Kharkiv Special Educational and Educational Complex named after V.G. Korolenko" held an event. During the event the solemn presentation of certificates to students who started their studies with the support of the Fund took place.

Among them there are 5 students of our University with special educational needs.


At the end of the festivities, a special concert was given by the students of the gymnasium.

The premises are being inspected for compliance with state building codes in terms of accessibility for low-mobility groups of the population, including persons with disabilities.

The department actively cooperates with the National Assembly of People with Disabilities of Ukraine, "Institute of Social Policy", Federation of Organizations of Persons with Disabilities from Childhood and Parents of Persons with Disabilities of Ukraine, exchange program future leaders of the US State Department – "FLEX" and others.

The "Mamba" and "Legion" teams met in the finals, and the "Legion" team won in a stubborn fight.

## Inclusive education for training and rehabilitation of persons with special educational needs

In the process of distance learning, the possibility of delivery of various elearning materials and ensuring constant communication between teachers and students in the mode of video conferencing comes to the fore. Distance learning should allow students to perceive information at different rates, based on the individual capabilities of each. One of the important features of distance education is the ability to teach students with disabilities. This training will be especially effective in the early stages of rehabilitation, as the student can feel like a full participant in the learning process. This feeling is reproduced through a virtual presence in the classroom with your academic group. This effect can be achieved by using panoramic video recording with the effect of presence. This uses special equipment, such as cameras with a spatial coverage of 360° and high resolution (at least 4K), which provides the ability to dynamically enlarge images without significant loss of quality and the effect of rasterization.

The advantages of using new educational technologies and tools are ease of implementation, originality of tests and flexible adaptation to different ages of a person or child with special educational needs, adaptation to various high-definition digital devices, ergonomics of wireless pen or stylus, use as an interactive simulator for pupils of specialized correctional educational institutions.

The main task of inclusive education in higher education institutions is to provide full and quality education to people with disabilities on equal terms, which will allow them to be realized in later life.


