Cooperation of education between Kharkov University and Stockholm university

This agreement is between Kateryna Solovyova from Kharkov National University of Radio Electronics and Harald Kjellin from Stockholm University. It concerns cooperation with teaching two university courses. One is called ICT for Cooperative Communication and the other is called Knowledge Technologies.

Agreements concerning the course ICT for Cooperative Communication (7,5 credits) Students from Kharkov University may register at Stockholm University without paying tuition for studying this course. Stockholm University will provide credits that are valid for universities within the European Union.

As the teaching of this course is done on distance from Stockholm, Kateryna Solovyova from Kharkov University will support the students locally at Kharkov when this is needed.

Agreements concerning the course Knowledge Technologies (7,5 credits)

At Stockholm University this course is called "Knowledge Management" while it is called "Knowledge Technologies" in Kharkov. The principle behind the agreement is that students at the two courses will attend the courses locally respectively in Stockholm and Kharkov, but student groups will be done together, i.e. every student group will solve a task that contains students from both universities.

Students from Stockholm may use online material from Kharkov University and students from Kharkov may use online material from Stockholm University.

Further cooperation concerning education and research

There are also plans of cooperation concerning research and knowledge management projects. This cooperation is to be formalized later on.
